White Wines

9. **La Vedette 'The Star' Chardonnay**

Languedoc, France (1/2)

Fuller-bodied ripe and creamy with tropical aromas followed by a wine with a crisp and wholesome palate.

Bottle - **£15.50**

10. **Alto Pampas del Sur Viognier**

Mendoza, Argentina (2/3)

Bright, full of flavour with overtones of honeysuckle, apricots and peaches. Tremendous value for money compared with a Northern Rhone Viognier

11. **Pinot Grigio Ca'Solare**

Lombardia, Italy (2)

A zesty, citrus and crunchy green apple Pinot with a well-balanced palate and a slightly creamy aftertaste.

12. **Marques de Caceres sin Crianza**

Rioja, Spain (1/2)

An intense bouquet of acacia flowers, pear drops and lemon preceding a more minerally flavour on the taste buds. From one of the most revered growers in Rioja.

13. **River Garden Sauvignon Blanc**

Stellenbosch, South Africa (2)

Winner of the Silver Medal at the 2008 Michaelangelo International Awards.

Delightfully light and crisp with complex Sauvignon nuances of ripe tropical fruits and perfect acidity.

14. **Grant Burge Barossa Vines Unoaked Chardonnay**

Barossa Valley, South Australia (2)

Generous aromas of melon and peach characters with a rich, rounded palate and a lingering finish. Grant Burge is undoubtedly one of the finest growers in all Australia having one every award there is to win!

15. *Black Tie* **Pinot Gris - Riesling**

Alsace, France (2/3)

Nestled between the Vosges mountains and the river Rhine lies the northerly region of Alsace.

This beautifully made wine is packed full of delicate flavours of nectarine, apricot and honey - full-bodied and dry with just a hint of sweetness.

Loire Valley, France (1)

A classic Sauvignon wine - smooth and elegant, crisp and fresh with mouth watering apple and grapefruit acidity.

17. **La Vedette 'The Star' Shiraz**
Languedoc, France (D)

A great combination of intense flavour and spiciness in this fuller-bodied red. Hand-picked grapes and bottled early to retain it's rich fruit character.

18. **Alto Pampas del Sur, Malbec**
Mendoza, Argentina (C)

Highly aromatic with a complex bouquet of earthy, stone fruit and elegant chocolate notes followed by a backdrop of demure blackberry.

19. **Barbera d'Asti, Ca'Solare**
Piedmonte, Italy (B/C)

Stylish and delightfully light from North-West Italy with black fruit aromas, a more dark cherry palate and a hint of pleasing dryness on the gums.

20. **Freedom Cross Cinsault/ Cabernet Sauvignon**
Franschhoek, South Africa (C)

From the 'Valley of the Huguenots', a succulent wine with masses of juicy blackcurrant fruit that fills the mouth. Certainly one to savour from the *French Corner (Franschhoek)* of South Africa.

21. **Vaqueras, Les Privilege des Vignerons**
Cotes du Rhone, France (C)

Deep garnet in colour, medium bodied yet full of vibrant redcurrant and strawberry flavours preceding a delicate and softly spicy, flavoursome palate.

Rioja, Spain (C/D)

A deep and full, complex nose of damson, plum, coffee and good toasty vanilla.
A lengthy palate of rustic, rich fruit and perfect balance of acidity and oak.

Colchagua Valley, Chile (C)

A sensational Pinot from the joint venture of world class winemaker's Robert Mondavi, California and Vina Errazuriz, Chile to create Caliterra. An expressive, silky smooth single vineyard wine.
